Year 2 Knowledge Organiser: Summer 1

Reading

Our class author this half term is Natahn Bryon and we will be exploring a number of his text such as Look Up!, Clean Up, Rocket Rules and Listen Up. During our Phonics reading lessons we will continue to focus on reading books that contain the sounds that we have already learnt, reading fluently, and developing our comprehension of what we have read. Our class read alouds will focus on our fluency and comprehension to deepen our understanding of what we have read.

Writing

Writing to entertain – In this unit of work we will be developing a more detailed descriptive writing style, reviewing and refining the use of expanded noun phrases and considering vocabulary to paint vivid pictures in their reader's mind.

This half term, we will build on our knowledge of fractions and develop a deeper understanding of halves, quarters, and thirds. We will also recognise the equivalence of half and two quarters. Later in the term we will be focusing on time. We will be deepen our understanding of the 12 hour clock and be able to recognise the time to five minutes and understand the amount of minutes in a hour.

Science

Our science topic for this half term is Solids, Liquids and Gases. We will understand that all materials are made of a single substance or a mixture of substances. We will deepen our knowledge and understand that there are three states of matter, which are, solids, liquids and gases.



Geography

Our Geography topic this half term is Rivers, Oceans and Seas. We will be locating the seas around the UK and oceans of the world. We will deepen our knowledge of physical and human features and be able to identify physical and human features around rivers and coastal areas.
