# Year 2 Knowledge Organiser: Summer 2

## Reading

Our class author this half term is Clotilde Perrin and we will be exploring a number of her texts such as Gotcha!, The House, Inside The Suitcase and The Same Moment Around The World. During our Phonics reading lessons we will continue to focus on reading books that contain the sounds that we have already learnt, reading fluently, and developing our comprehension of what we have read. Our class read alouds will focus on our fluency and comprehension to deepen our understanding of what we have read.

#### Writing

Writing to persuade – In this unit of work we will be developing our writing techniques to create a persuasive piece of text. In this unit of work we will be focusing on the text 'The Promise' By Nicola Davies.

Writing to inform - In this unit of work we will developing our understanding of the writing techniques used when we are writing to inform. For this unit of work we will be reading the text 'Africa, Amazing Africa' by Atinuke.

Writing to entertain – To end the term we will be continuing to develop our understanding of creating narrative. We will focus of the different word classes that we can use to paint vivid images in the readers' mind.

### Maths

This half term, we will build on our knowledge of statistics and position & direction. We will develop a deeper understanding of tally charts, table and pictograms and be able to interpret them. For position and direction we will be able to describe the movements and turns and develop our understanding of shaping patterns with tur

## **Science**

For our final term in Year 2 we will be consolidating and reviewing all our science topics that we have already studied. We will be reviewing the needs of animals, habitats, everyday use of materials and solid, liquids and gases.

### **History**

Our History topic this half term is explorers. We will be exploring the similarities and differences between the lives of Sacagawea and Michael Collins and looking in detail at the expeditions they undertook.

#### **Technology**

Our Technology this half term is 'Glove Puppets'. We will be designing our own glove puppets and considering which materials are suitable for our glove puppets. We will also be exploring some new sewing techniques.

Music This half term, we will be consolidating and reviewing all the music that we have learnt over the year. We will be revisiting some of the songs we have learnt and performing them one last time.

## **Religion and World Views** In RE this half term, we will be exploring and considering how do celebrations give Hindus a sense of belonging? We will look in detail at some of the Hindu celebrations

such as Diwali.

# Reading


