# Year 4 Knowledge Organiser: Autumn 2

#### Reading

Our class author this half term is Vashti Hardy and we are currently reading 'Crowfall' as our class read aloud. Our reading lessons consist of vocabulary, where we explore root words and a component of close/extended reading sessions. We also focus on skills sessions during daily shared reading sessions. This half term, we are reading: Dragonology, Why do we wear poppies?, The Story Shop, Agent Zaiba and the Missing Diamonds, as well as poetry.

### Writing

Writing to inform- We will be reading the book 'Dragonology', and then writing our own non-fiction report and a letter.

Writing short stories- We will be reading the book 'The Story Shop', and then write their own short story creating and developing character, setting and plot.

#### Maths

This half term, we will be building on our learning from Year 3 with the topic 'area'. We will be learning how to calculate area by counting the squares within the shape, and we will also be comparing area. We will also be looking at multiplication and division, having previously taught addition and subtraction. We will also be learning the 9 times table this half term too.

#### Science

We will be looking at Food and Digestion. We will be exploring teeth, as well as digestion. We will learn about the different teeth and the different uses they all have. We will then learn in detail about the digestive system and also make our own digestive system to see for ourselves exactly how it works.

#### History

Our history topic this half term is looking at North American history focussing on the Ancient Maya. Our learning will comprise of: understanding life for the Ancient Maya, and comparing this with that of the Ancient Greeks and Ancient Egyptians, which was taught in Year 3.



#### DT

We will be tasting, designing and creating our own soups. We will be tasting soups and then design our own based on our preferences. We will then learn how to prepare and cook soup.

#### Music

This half term, we will be continuing to learn clarinets with our music tutor. We will building on our knowledge of how to assemble all the parts and learn to play more notes.

### Religion and World Views

This half term, we will be focusing on Theology.
Our key question is 'What does sacrifice mean?'.
Our key learning will consist of various lessons answering this question.
