Year 4 Knowledge Organiser: Spring 1

Reading

Our class author this half term is Annabelle Sami and we are currently reading 'Agent Saiba Investigates — The Missing Diamonds' as our class read aloud. Our reading lessons consist of vocabulary, where we explore root words and a component of close/extended reading sessions. We also focus on skills sessions during daily reading sessions. This half term, we are reading: Arabian Nights, The Rhythm of the Rain, and the Atlas of Animal Adventures.

Writing

Creating narratives - We will be reading the book 'Arabian Nights' to develop characters, setting and plot, before creating their own to use when writing a new, original tale.

Dual purpose writing - We will be reading the book 'Atlas of Animal Adventures' to plan, write and record their own dual purpose wildlife voiceovers.

Maths

This half term, we will be continuing with our multiplication and division topic. We will then move onto the topic of measurement with a focus on length and perimeter. We will also be learning the 11 times table this half term too. Children will also have time to practise their times tables on TT Rockstars, which enables children to practise all of the times tables they have learnt previously.

Sciences

We will be looking at Chemistry: Particle Model — States of matter. We will be exploring solids, liquids and gases and then learning about the water cycle. We are going to Ewden Water Treatment Works on the 17th January 2024 to see the water cycle in action!



History

Our history topic this half term is looking at Early Islamic Civilisation. Our learning will comprise of: reading maps, medicine, as well as medical treatments that were used.

To further enhance this topic we will be visiting a Mosque in Sheffield.



DT

We will be learning about, designing and making our own pulley.



Music

This half term, we will be continuing to learn clarinets with our music tutor. We will building on our knowledge of how to assemble all the parts and learn to play more notes.

Religion and World Views

This half term, we will be focusing on Philosophy.
Our key question is 'How do people think about poverty, justice & self-sacrifice?' and this will be answered in various ways.

You can also support your child by providing them with opportunities to practice their handwriting and spellings.
