## Year 5 Knowledge Organiser: Spring 2

#### Reading

The class author focus for Year 5, is Charlie Higson "Silverfin". We will be reading this each day in class throughout Spring 2. In our class reading sessions, we will cover a variety of texts including: The Jungle Book by Rudyard Kipling, Coghart by Peter Bunzl, Survivors by David Long (non-fiction) and The Listeners (poetry) by Walter De La Mere. We will build on a range of reading skills.

#### Writing

To start of the half term, we will be writing to entertain. The unit will focus on the book Cloud by Malorie Blackman and from reading this the children will write a narrative poem. After this, we will write a biography based on someone who survived from the book "Survivors" by David Long. This book looks at different survivors.

#### Maths

In Maths, we will explore shape and calculate the perimeter of rectilinear and polygon shapes as well as finding the area of compound shapes and rectangles. We will learn how to identify missing lengths within a compound shape before calculating the area. Linking to measurement, will be the use of statistics including line graphs and timetables.

#### Science

Our Science focus is within the strand of Biology where we will continue developing our understanding of life cycles. We will start with the life cycle of a human before developing our knowledge of gestation periods. We will look at similarities and differences between humans and animals.

#### History

In History, we will learn about the Roman Empire in Britain. First, we will explore the Roman conquest for Britain before moving onto leadership in Britannia and identifying who the local leaders were. Finally, we will debate if there was a shared culture between Britain and Rome – or was it all rebellious?

#### D.T.

In DT, we will be making our own sauces to compliment food. In this exciting and mouthwatering topic we will taste, make and evaluate sauces. While learning new skills, along the way.

#### Music This half term, we will be continuing to use Charanga. Our unit is 'The Fresh Prince of Bel Air'. Pupils will be practicing and performing 'The Fresh Prince of Bel Air' by Will

Religion and Worldviews During our learning we will explore the question "How have events in history shaped Christian diversity". We will discuss the impact of The Roman Emperor Constantine converting to Christianity.

#### **PE** Wednesday is our P.E. day. Please ensure your child has a full P.E. kit.

P.E. will incorporate how we can live a healthy life.

#### PHSE

The focus of our PSHE lessons will be on relationship. We will look at how we can communicate in a friendly way with our friends.
