Reading

The class author focus for Year 5, is Katherine Rundell "The Wolf Wilder". We will be reading this each day in class throughout Autumn 2. Writing

The first piece of writing is focussed on creating an additional chapter for the book "The invention of Hugo Cabret". In this unit, the children will write to entertain and this includes making a new character to join the story. After this, the children will focus on writing to inform and create a explanation text about how things work.

Maths

This half term in Maths we will focus on the unit of Fractions. Within this unit, we will explore equivalent fractions, comparing fractions and mixed number fractions. During this topic, the children multiplication knowledge is required so please continue to practise times tables on TT Rockstars and Hit the button.

Science

Our Science focus combines biology, chemistry and physics. The focus is energy. Energy is required for living and non-living things. This could be in the form a renewable or non-renewable source. The children will build on their knowledge of electricity from Y4.

History
