Year 6 Knowledge Organiser: Autumn 2

Reading

Our class author this half term is Robert Swindells and we are currently reading 'Room 13' as our class read aloud. Our reading lessons consist of vocabulary, where we explore root words and a component of close/extended reading sessions. We also focus on skills sessions, which supports pupils in preparation for SATs. This half term, we are reading: Seabean, The Rooftoppers, We are All Greta and The Crossover.

Writing

Writing to entertain- We will be writing a new chapter for 'Seabean', which is a Sci-fi text discussing environmental issues. We will read our finished chapters to Year 4 during our reading buddy session.

Writing to persuade-We will be writing persuasive speeches and creating persuasive texts in relation to environmental issues. We will be reading 'We are Greta' and using her speeches as inspiration for our own.

Maths

This half term, we will be building on our learning from Year 5 in fractions. We will be learning how to simplify and find equivalent fractions, add and subtract improper and mixed fractions and multiply and divide mixed and improper fractions. We will be practicing our skills using the online platform, learning by questions.

Science

We will be looking at the theory of evolution. We will be exploring adaptation, variation and natural selection. We will also be researching information about Charles Darwin. Later on in the year, we will be going to the Moorland discovery centre, which is a trip linked to our Evolution topic.



Our Geography topic this half term is Improving the Environment. We will be locating the great garbage patch on a map, researching renewable and non-renewable energy and the detrimental impact of environmental issues. We will be writing a discussion text focusing on how different countries are addressing the plastic problem.



Art

We will be collecting recycled materials to create art, which has been inspired by artists such as *Ifeoma Anyaej*. Our topic links to our current writing text and Geography unit.

Music

This half term, we will be continuing to use Charanga. Our unit is 'Happy'. Pupils will be practicing performing 'Happy' by Pharrell.

Religion and World Views

This half term, we will be exploring whether religion is conflict with Science. We will be looking at this through the lens of the Gospel and the life and beliefs of Pope Francis.
